各位家長、同學和求恩人：

在本期家書中，我想和大家介紹求恩校友——謝子和主教(The Rt. Revd. Matthias DER)的故事。上世紀70年代，謝師兄在台灣完成小學學業後，來到香港並入讀本校，開始初中階段的學習。我記得謝師兄曾經分享，他參加求恩的入學考試時連26個英文字母都不認識。後來，經過自身的努力，他在多倫多大學取得社會學文學士學位及神道學碩士學位，並在加拿大聖公會多倫多聖基道牧區擔任主任牧師長達20年。他在任期間，聖基道牧區得到擴展。及後，他成為了香港聖約翰座堂(St. John's Cathedral)第二位華人堂主任(Dean)，2021年1月2日更陞座成為香港聖公會香港島教區第三任主教。

我們能從謝主教的故事中得到什麼啟示呢？我想，教育是可以鼓舞人、改變人的。正所謂「十年樹木，百年樹人」。無論同學的起點如何，只要我們滿懷信念，身體力行，成長和改變便會在春風化雨、潤物無聲中悄然發生。多年來，李求恩紀念中學孕育了許多優秀的校友，他們在各行各業都有卓越的成就，全賴各位求恩的老師不忘教育的初心，用心栽培學生。願各位同學對自己充滿信心，努力提升自己，發揮自身潛能，相信大家都能超越自我，獲得突破和成功。

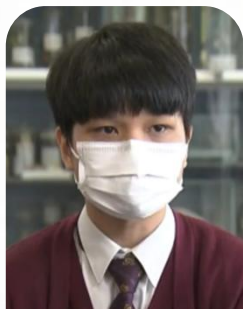
